- All companies can get up to \$100 000.
- Quebec reimburses 100% of the eligible costs (salaries up to an hourly rate of \$25 (for 25% to 100% of the total hours paid), instructor's fees, the purchase of materials and human resources management fees).
- All companies are eligible, regardless of their size or industry, whether or not they are considered as an essential service, or even if they are open or closed.

"Let's take advantage of April to increase our profiles", that's the slogan of Jean Boulet, Minister of Employment, Work and Solidarity (l'Emploi, du Travail et de la Solidarité). The action program for job retention *Programme actions concertées pour le maintien en emploi (PACME-COVID-19)* will enable us to prepare the reorganization of work and maintain employees who continue receiving their pay.

"Eligible training includes digital skills, organizational communication, languages, marketing, online commerce, business development or any other training that fundamentally aims to increase employee know-how", stated Minister Boulet.
